The service combines the BelAir100 and BelAir200 Multi-service Switch Routers with the Pronto OSS. Pronto and BelAir also get their sales and marketing teams together to work on channel programs, cross training, joint marketing and sales, and customer opportunities.

The installation so far includes four BelAir100 and one BelAir200 Wireless Multi-service Nodes mounted on buildings in the downtown area.

Pronto's OSS monitors system availability and performance, provides customer care, billing, and reporting, and more.
